- 5. School Report RancheView Administration Sharon Cronin
 - RancheView has a new learning support teacher effective March 13th
 - Basketball team has been successful
 - New round of "options" classes have begun
 - School now has a wood shop which will be outfitted and staffed in the Fall with either an instructor specific to the skill in conjunction with a teacher to supervise the teaching aspect, or possibly hiring a new teacher who also happens to possess the skill set
 - An order of sewing machines has arrived for the textiles option course
 - Silent auction items have been a success, will likely repeat
 - Getting ready for the school's Grand Opening event March 23rd; Representatives from grades K-7 will be MC'ing as well as representatives from K-7 who will be speaking
 - Recently held the "We Lead" bake sale this past week with help from the culinary arts students
 - Getting ready for Spring Break
 - Have begun looking at staffing for next year; Conservatively adding 4 classes: one of each grades 1 and 2, and two grade 8 classes

Trustee Report – Fiona Gilbert

- Discussed the provincial budget; Alberta government appears to be working to protect education and health
- Part of budget plan includes Fee Reduction Grant which acts to reduce school fees, part of which includes transportation costs; Plenty of questions around how it will affect us; More information to follow
- New budget allows for 10 new schools across the province. RockyView is allotted one, which will be in Airdrie; This is the first new school for RockyView in 2.5 years.
- Discussed capital planning for 2018-2021; lists the needs for new schools. Airdrie would need one new school per year to keep up with need; Cochrane needs another K-9 school.
- New budget includes playgrounds for new schools to be funded by the province; Have not yet heard if this will include RancheView
- There will be a joint Board / Council meeting taking place March 30th at the head office in Airdrie from 5:30pm 7:30pm
- 7. RancheView School Fundraising Society Update Jakki Mackenzie
 - 6 Fabulous Vacations fundraiser has begun; in the first week apprx 100 tickets have been sold; signage will be going up around town to advertise.
 - April 11th is Small Business night at the school; tables are almost sold out
 - RVFS will be hosting a movie night in May; letter will be going out soon
 - RVFS will be hosting a year end party in June; would appreciate if Council could assist by arranging / hosting food or beverage for the event; Ideas discussed included either bringing in a food truck, arranging for beverages, or Texas Doughnuts as an example has been a success at other schools previous events
 - Total cash raised to date is \$65,700
 - There is an additional \$5000 donation coming in from The Clothesline, which is not included in the above total
 - Looking to do another bottle drive May 26th

 - Administration of Fun Lunch has gotten easier with the use of School Cash online
 - Trying a new vendor for this week's fun Lunch, Boston Pizza
 - Fun Lunch has been going well; all dates through to the end of June are up
