**Dear Parents,**

It is time to start a new round of leader of the day. I will be sending home a copy of the blank '**All About Me**' poster template with your child to be completed **with you**. On this sheet, your child can add photographs or draw pictures. This project is **due on their leadership day as scheduled below**. These posters will be presented as a project and is to be filled out by your child (you can help them write some words). I will be marking your child on how they speak and conduct themselves as a kindergarten speaker. Once again please have your child practice presenting their poster to you at home.

The top rectangular box of the "**All About Me**" poster is for your child to print their first and last name, the **star** is for their age, the square is for your child to draw/glue a picture of his/her family, the "**me**" circle is for your child to draw/glue a picture of themselves, "**groups**" is for your child to draw/glue pictures of groups they belong to (sports teams, church, Beavers, dance, family, school, etc), "**I don't like**" is for him/her to draw/glue pictures of things they do not like (avocado, roller coasters, spiders...) and at the bottom they can draw/glue pictures of an animal they like, colour the balloon their favourite color, and finally there is a space for their favourite meal. Please take the time and decorate the poster with a **border using a pattern** we have done in class (ABAB, AABB, ABC...). We have studied patterns in math. This pattern can be done with drawings, colours or stickers.

This project is great for us to discuss how your child is unique, an objective from the Social Studies curriculum. You may mount this poster on a piece of inexpensive poster board if you wish.
