5. Executive Reports
 - a. President - Aaron Gertzen

 - b. School Requests for Funds
 - i. Portable bike racks, to be placed near Grade 1 and 2 end of building. Costs are approximately \$1400 for 10' to hold 18 bikes, \$2400 for 20' to hold 36 bikes,

\$3400 for 30' to hold 54 bikes. Best fit will likely be two of the 20' racks. Lynette will contact supplier to receive pricing for scooter racks also, they are more costly, currently scooters are being stored in classrooms.
