What Does "In Good Standing" Mean?

Our students represent the school and must exemplify the attitudes, leadership and behavioural expectations for which the school stands. Participation in extra-curricular activities is a privilege and students who wish to participate must be in-good-standing at the school.

To be in-good-standing means that you must have fulfilled all the following requirements:

- a) Your teachers are satisfied that your assignments are up to date and that you are contributing to the classroom environment in a positive manner (meaning no behavioral concerns).
- b) Ms. Cronin is satisfied that you have been a contributing member of the school community and you have not been sent to the office for behavioral concerns (Ms. Cronin may consult with any appropriate staff).
