- * Why do we say a Land Acknowledgement? What is the purpose?*
- The Land Acknowledgement is an act of reconciliation and is meant to honor and respect both the land and the Indigenous Peoples in our local area.
- The Land Acknowledgement recognizes a longer history reaching beyond introduction of settlers. Indigenous peoples are known as 'stewards of the land' and have a connectedness to the land and all things.
- The Land Acknowledgement is meant to be an expression of gratitude and appreciation. As settlers, we should consider how we situate ourselves on this land in order to understand our place in history.
- To honor the land allows us to acknowledge history, peoples, and the future.
- The Land Acknowledgement may start the conversations about Canadian history and may be one gesture to help us to move forward together with Indigenous peoples as equal partners.
- It is meant to create a more welcoming environment for Indigenous students and to provide a culture of safe and caring schools for everyone.
