Topic: TRAFFIC SCHOOL SAFETY – Sharon C.

We have 3 main cross walk areas supported by several Teachers, parent volunteers and a retired gentleman (Reg). We are in need of more support from parents even if it's just 1 morning or afternoon per week. If we had enough support then we could set-up a rota system. The students who assist are trained to help. Sharon to talk to Grade 5 teachers to discuss getting more students involved. Continued safety issues regarding parents driving to fast, parking too close or on top of the cones, parking on or over the crosswalk areas and a general lack of responsibility for the pupils, other parents and teachers. Often the students are coming out of school looking at phones, not looking where they are going and not checking the road before crossing. It was suggested we could put out more cones in certain areas too. Buses must always have priority at all times in and out of school. It was discussed if we could look into trialling a drop and go system and a walking bus? Great ideas with parent power we could do this?!
